

Publication Activities

In addition to publishing a wide range of books and articles dealing with the whole gamut of Asian studies, The Toyo Bunko is also involved in compiling and publishing catalogues of the valuable holdings contained in the Library collections, in order to facilitate their dissemination among research institutions and scholars both at home and abroad. Since its foundation, The Toyo Bunko has authored and edited a total of 1000 publications (as of 31 March 2007). Major journals and series include:

Toyo Gakuho (Journal of the Research Department of The Toyo Bunko)

Publication was begun by the Oriental Association in 1911, then was shifted to The Toyo Bunko.

Memoirs of the Research Department of The Toyo Bunko

First published in 1926. A well-regarded international Western language periodical introducing to the world Asian studies research being done in Japan.

Toyo Bunko Ronso Series

A Japanese language series of monographs containing research on Asian history, archaeology, language, religion, and thought. Publication was begun in 1924, and the series now boasts 62 volumes. In addition,

there are 9 volumes in the Ronso Series of western language translations of important Japanese research. In 2001, a new western language series of monographs, on contemporary and historical studies of Asian countries was published as *The Toyo Bunko Research Library*.

Toyo Bunko Shoho

Publication began in 1970. A yearly serial introducing with philological commentary the titles contained in The Toyo Bunko's Library.

Toyo Bunko Sokan

A series of photographic reproductions (with commentary) of rare and valuable books preserved in The Toyo Bunko Library. Since publication began in 1919, and disseminated to research institutes and scholars throughout the world.

Toyo Bunko Nenpo

A yearly report of the many activities in which The Toyo Bunko is involved. Publication began in 1957.
